

Taking care of your clarinet

- 1) Always depress the upper bridge key when putting your clarinet together to avoid colliding with the lower bridge key and damaging both keys.
 - 2) Use cork grease when it is difficult to put your instrument together.
 - 3) Always swab your instrument out when you finish playing.
 - 4) Always take your reed off of your mouthpiece and store it in a reed case when you finish playing.
 - 5) Never store anything on top of your clarinet in the case.

What your maintenance covers:

Once a year cleaning

Regular adjustments & regulation

Key corks as needed

Up to 5 pads over the 3 year contract

Up to 3 tenon corks over the 3 year contract
