

Taking care of your trumpet

- 1) Never tap your mouthpiece into the trumpet. Simply put it in the receiver and give a slight twist as you push.
 - 2) Remember to use valve oil when your valves move slower than normal.
 - 3) Never use anything to try to remove a stuck valve or slide. Take it to a repair shop.
 - 4) Never put your trumpet down on the 2nd valve slide (the one that sticks out away from the body of the trumpet). That can cause damage to the slide & valves.
 - 5) Never store anything on top of your trumpet in the case.

What your maintenance covers:

Once a year hand cleaning

Once a contract Sonic Cleaning

Up to 2 water key corks over the 3 year contract

Up to 3 valve guides over the 3 year contract

Stuck mouthpieces

Up to 2 frozen slides removed over the 3 year contract
