

Taking care of your flute

- 1) Always swab your flute when you're finished playing.
 - 2) Never mess with the crown, or adjustment screws without a teacher or professional's help.
 - 3) Never store anything on top of your flute in the case.
 - 4) Avoid putting any kind of sticker or tape on the flute. If you need to mark your finger positions, use painter's tape, as it will not leave any kind of residue when removed.
 - 5) Pay attention to the positioning of your flute parts in the case, putting it in wrong can damage the flute.
