

Taking care of your saxophone

- 1) Always use a neck strap when you play your saxophone
 - 2) Avoid putting your saxophone down on the table keys. This can bend those keys. Instead place it down on the “front” where the posts can hold the saxophone up and prevent the keys from being bent.
 - 3) Always swab your instrument out when you finish playing. – make sure you use the appropriate swab. (The neck has it’s own swab that is smaller to fit in the smaller tube.)
 - 4) Always take your reed off of your mouthpiece and store it in a reed case when you finish playing.
 - 5) Never store anything on top of your Saxophone in the case.

What your maintenance covers:

Once a year cleaning

Regular adjustments & regulation

Key corks as needed

Up to 1 neck cork over the 3 year contract

Up to 6 pads over the 3 year contract
